

LASER RANGEFINDER With Quintero's elevated tees, we know how a good rangefinder is essential to getting an accurate distance reading. Don't rely on your smart phone GPS that will simply measure point A to point B. We love the Bushnell Tour V4 Slope Rangefinder. Its Slope Technology compensates for elevation to give you the most accurate distance to the hole.

GOLF COURSE APPS Most major courses now have apps that give you insights into each hole, keep track of your score, as well as other amenities. Our Quintero Course App has fly-over videos, for example. These apps are easy to download from Google Play or the Apple Store and let you plan your attack before you even set up your first tee.

PUTTER WHEEL Sometimes a tech tool doesn't have to be complicated. When playing on bentgrass greens, like we have at Quintero, the ability to roll the ball correctly is critical. The Putter Wheel is one of the best training aids I've seen for improving your putting. The "wheel" is actually a pseudo ball designed to wobble if not hit correctly. It gives the golfer immediate feedback on the stroke and, with training, practice helps the person develop their eye and putting form. —M.L.
